Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information as a client of Unicon Group Ltd. and tells You about Your privacy rights and how the law protects You.

We use Your Personal data solely for the purpose of carrying out our obligations in servicing You as a customer. By entering into a customer relationship with Us, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- Account means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of our Service.
- **Application** means the software program(s) provided by the Company to You. The Application may have been sold, leased or provided on a temporary basis for test purposes.
- **Company** (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Unicon Group Ltd., 1748 Gilsinn Lane, Fenton, MO 63026.
- **Country** refers to: Missouri, United States
- **Personal Data** is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.
- Service refers to the sale, maintenance, support and training of the Application.
- Service Provider refers to individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of the Company or to perform services related to the Service.

• You means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Collecting your Personal Data

The only personally identifiable information we collect from You is limited to that which is required for communication purposes.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- To manage Your requests. To attend to and manage Your requests to Us.

We may share Your personal information in the following situations:

• With Your consent only. Your personal information will never be shared with a third party. If a situation arises in which you or a third party would have a vested interest in communication, we would facilitate such communication only with the consent of both parties.

Retention of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain Your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use Your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating office and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those of Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of Your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of Your data and other personal information.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, Your Personal Data may be transferred. We will provide notice before Your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

Law enforcement
